Earlscliffe is an independent sixth form college Earlscliffe is based on the Kent coast, yet only 53 minutes from central London

Eastcliffe was established in 2012 in Folkestone, East Sussex, and provides GCSE, A Level. Diploma in Business and Foundation Year courses to students aged 15 - 17.
